



Dear Fifth Grader,

Welcome to fifth grade! ☺ We look forward to meeting you and are excited about our plans for the upcoming year. In order to help you start the year off in an organized fashion, we have compiled the following list of supplies you will need for the school year. We encourage you to take this list with you when you do your “back to school” shopping. The supplies you will need are:

Binders/Folders:

- 4 **soft covered** three-ring binders with 1” rings in the following colors: green, red, blue, black – DO NOT buy spiral notebooks or Trapper Keepers
- 1 **hard cover**, three-ring binder with 1” rings and side pockets (design/color is personal choice)
- 5 sets of **“write-on”** and **“erasable”** tab dividers- NOT the dividers with the slide in tabs. (Please do not label these at home. We will label them during the first week of school.)
- Wide-ruled notebook paper (NOT college ruled)
- A folder with pockets for take-home notices (we suggest buying 2 or 3 to keep home in case one gets misplaced or torn)

Writing Utensils:

- 1 box of #2 pencils (sharpened at home)
- 2 red pens and 2 blue pens to be used for correcting
- 2 boxes of 12 count colored pencils (1 for school and 1 for home)
- 1 package of dry erase markers and an eraser (a sock can also be used as an eraser – and it’s free☺)
- A zippered pencil pouch (NOT a box – as it is too bulky to keep in a desk)
- 1 package of highlighters
- 1 box of magic markers

Other supplies:

- art smock with name on it
- 2 boxes of tissues for classroom use
- 1 large glue stick
- 1 flash drive- not all brands will work on school computers. Some brands that work well: Lexar Fireflies, Memorex, and Attache. A brand that WILL NOT work: SanDisk Cruzer. We have found that drives with the Ready Boost program on them do not work at school.
